



## Spelling: Linking Reading & Writing Workshop 2025

### **I. WORKSHOP DESCRIPTION:**

This is a lecture and laboratory workshop designed to enhance Educational Therapists, teachers, school administrators, or parents' ability to develop students' concepts of spelling using a multi-modal structured literacy approach.

### **II. WORKSHOP OBJECTIVES:**

Upon completion of this course, the participant will understand how:

1. Spelling is a cognitive activity.
2. Morphology aids in comprehension and spelling.
3. Etymology provides answers for unusual spellings.
4. Spelling provides a link between decoding and encoding. Educators will demonstrate the ability to design and use the Spelling Investigation Technique using a Structured Word Inquiry.
